Parks are listed by Region starting in the North with the North Coast, followed by Shasta-Cascade-Trinity, San Francisco, Central Coast, Central Valley, Gold Country, High Sierra, Los Angeles/Orange County, San Diego, Inland Empire and the Deserts. Within the Regions, parks are listed by town or city and are generally listed from North to South.

- 4. Directions:** Give clear, precise directions to your park. Include Hwy exit numbers if possible.
- 5. General Information:** Draw RVers and campers to your park with descriptive information that makes your park stand out. Highlight what's unique to your park, amenities that you offer, etc. If you need more room than what's offered on the following page, feel free to attach an additional page.
- 6. Map:** Submit either a hand-drawn map or one from another publication, brochure, etc.
- 7. Guide Amenities:** These amenities will be added to the amenity grid that precedes each Region in the printed Guide.
- 8. Online amenities:** These are searchable amenities that your potential customers can search on when looking for a park online at Camp-California.com.


